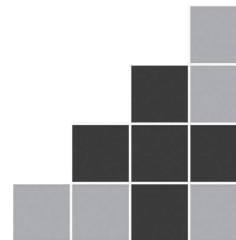

# Funds Available for PQA Plus

## REBATE PROGRAM CONTINUED!

**PQA Plus = Education Session + Site Assessment**



The Illinois Pork Producers Association (IPPA), the National Pork Board (NPB) and National Pork Producers Council (NPPC), are encouraging all pork producers to become PQA Plus certified.

IPPA, NPB and NPPC have allocated funds to offer \$50 per site that is assessed in 2010. Producers may request the rebate for up to 2 sites per premise registration number. The program is not retroactive and began effective May 22, 2009. Site assessments performed prior to May 22, 2009, are not eligible for the rebate.

To be eligible for this incentive, producers must have:

- Completed the education component of PQA Plus
- All paperwork completed with corresponding premise registration numbers, including the site assessment and submitted to NPB
- Proof of the above submitted to the IPPA office.

The purpose of this program is to encourage pork producers to be proactive in providing the best possible care for their pigs. Having an extension professional, veterinarian or other swine industry professional systematically review your operation allows another set of eyes to identify potential improvement areas that might not otherwise be noticed.

**Limited funds are available and will be distributed on a first come, first served basis.**
